LATE SHREE RAJPAL KAPOOR FOUNDATION

(An initiative taken by Ramanand Arya D.A.V. College to provide assistance to economically-disadvantaged students of the institution while pursuing their higher education)

The foundation has been established by the college in memory of the illustrious first Hony. Secretary of Uttari Bharat Sabha, the managing body of the institution, Late Shree Rajpal Kapoor. The main aim of the Foundation is to mobilise financial resources to provide assistance to the deserving students who belong to the financially disadvantaged section of the community, through monetary and material help. Annual scholarships are provided to the selected students through their bank accounts. They are provided access to study material through the Book Bank created by the college.

The monetary resources for this initiative are mobilised through the following steps taken by the institution:

- Under the 'Share a Rupee' scheme, the interested students and faculty members are provided an opportunity to contribute one rupee every week in the collection boxes circulated by student-volunteers in all the class rooms.
- The Department of Self Financing Programmes is operating the 'Care & Share' scheme wherein students and faculty members of the department periodically contribute their mite in the collection boxes circulated by the student volunteers.
- Donation boxes are provided in the campus to enable interested people to offer their donations for this cause.
- The student volunteers of the National Service Scheme unit of the college also raise funds for this purpose.
- Contributions are made by the alumni, philanthropists and other well-wishers from time to time in the collection boxes kept for this purpose in the college campus.

The resources collected are deposited in a separate bank account with Punjab National Bank who are one of the bankers to the college. This account is operated by a team of three faculty members. Disbursals are made to the deserving students who are selected through an established process of calling for applications, scrutiny, personal interviews by a panel and final selection of the most deserving students. The sanctioned amount is transferred to their individual bank accounts directly. Proper accounts of the collection and disbursement of funds are maintained by the accounts department, under the supervision of the head of the institution.
