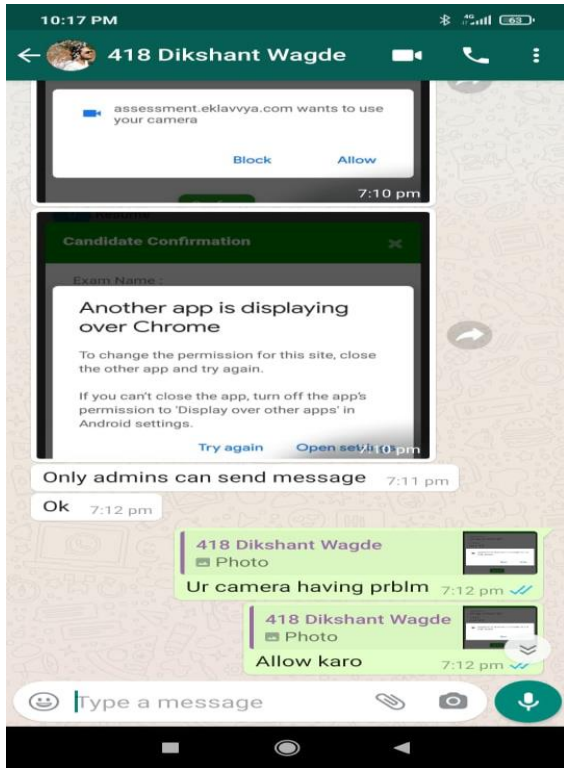

1	<b>Unavailability of text books and reference books during lockdown:</b> In the lockdown period books were not available for the students to study. Although lectures were going on online, but for study material students were dependant on ppts used by teachers in class. For subjects like Accounting and Maths even referring ppts was not possible.	To make books available to the student softcopies of books were created. Those students who had books were given a task to create the PDF of text books and same was distributed within their classmates.
2	<b>Fees payment:</b> Due to financial crises during lockdown some of the students face issues to pay fees on time.	The time flexibility to pay college fees was given to the students as per instructions of college authorities.
3	<b>Assistance to students for online exam:</b> As online exam was new to the students they initially faced challenges.	- Demo exam was organised by college exam committee. - A meeting of students with BBI exam in-charge (Vaishali Behere) was conducted so they could solve their queries related to online exam beforehand.
4	<b>Non-monetary support to the student</b>	One student was provided with material to make cloth bags to sell and earn some money to tide over the financial crisis in her family.

3. Some students were asking for the Job, I informed them about the job opportunities available.



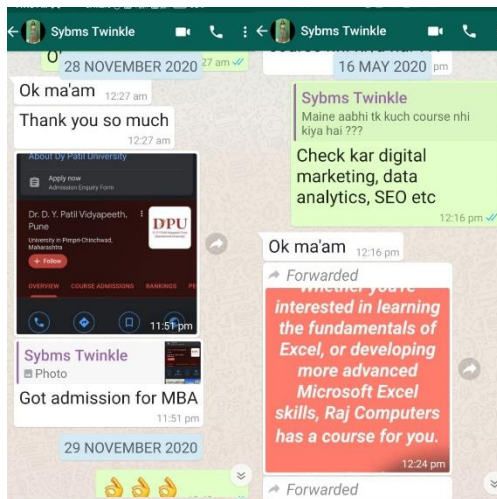
4. Some parents were worried about the payment of fees because of Loss of job, Pandemic situations etc. Resolved their issues after discussing with higher authorities.
