

- Please share a brief description of how you planned and executed the campaign:

On 3rd May 2021, a session on ‘Youth against COVID 19’ was organized for POs of various colleges. Before that NSS volunteers of Ramanand Arya DAV College were generating awareness regarding vaccination and importance of blood donation before getting the dose of vaccine.

Myself and NSS leader created a personal group of NSS volunteers who were interested in this event. Both of us discussed the benefit of this program with volunteers. Link of registration form is circulated among the group.

We requested United Way to organize training session for volunteers on 17th May 2021. They agreed and the session went wonderfully. Students asked their doubts and started preparing for the next step.

With the help of United way, UNICEF and University of Mumbai volunteers received authentic information and way of sharing it on social media. They also understood the exact way of generating awareness using social media effectively.

Simultaneously, students were also working with Mahatma Gandhi National Council for Rural Education under the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India to collect the information regarding people providing food to covid patients, vaccination centres, doctors providing online consultation etc. Students also made some videos, posters for COVID 19 awareness.

- Have there been any challenges w.r.t Youth Against COVID campaign? If yes, please mention in detail.

This program was initiated when students have already completed their semester exams and some of them have gone to their villages in no network area. Cyclone hit us on the day of training session therefore some students could not attend the complete session.

Note of each and every point mentioned in the training session was circulated among the students on WhatsApp so that those who have missed some part of lecture can understand the session thoroughly. United Way conducted another session for those who missed the session.

Some of the students started working during this time period because of unavoidable financial reasons, one student works in COVID centre, some students were still stuck in villages where network is very weak. We tried to overcome all the hurdles and continued with our work.

- Have there been any measures undertaken by you/your college to motivate students to actively undertake and fulfil their responsibilities in the campaign?

We made our personal WhatsApp group at initial stage for any personal discussion or for solving their doubts. This can be done by the teacher at first place and if teacher feels it appropriate, he /she can get it solved by the coordinators of United Way.

Volunteers were encouraged to ask doubts during the session by using this personal communication channel. They were appreciated for their good work time to time. Timely reminder and important part in the notices were highlighted in the personal group.


Five teams were made of ten students each in which one student was selected as team leader who coordinated with his/her team mates for getting updates of the activity. These team leaders were in constant touch with the Program Officer in charge.

Students were little hesitant at the time of video making or sharing of testimonials, maybe because TY students were busy with their report submissions and examinations. But during the activity of awareness generation by telephonic conversation, most of them made more than 25 calls per student.

Some myths were busted because of training session. We as a team understood the importance of using social media appropriately so as to reach maximum people.







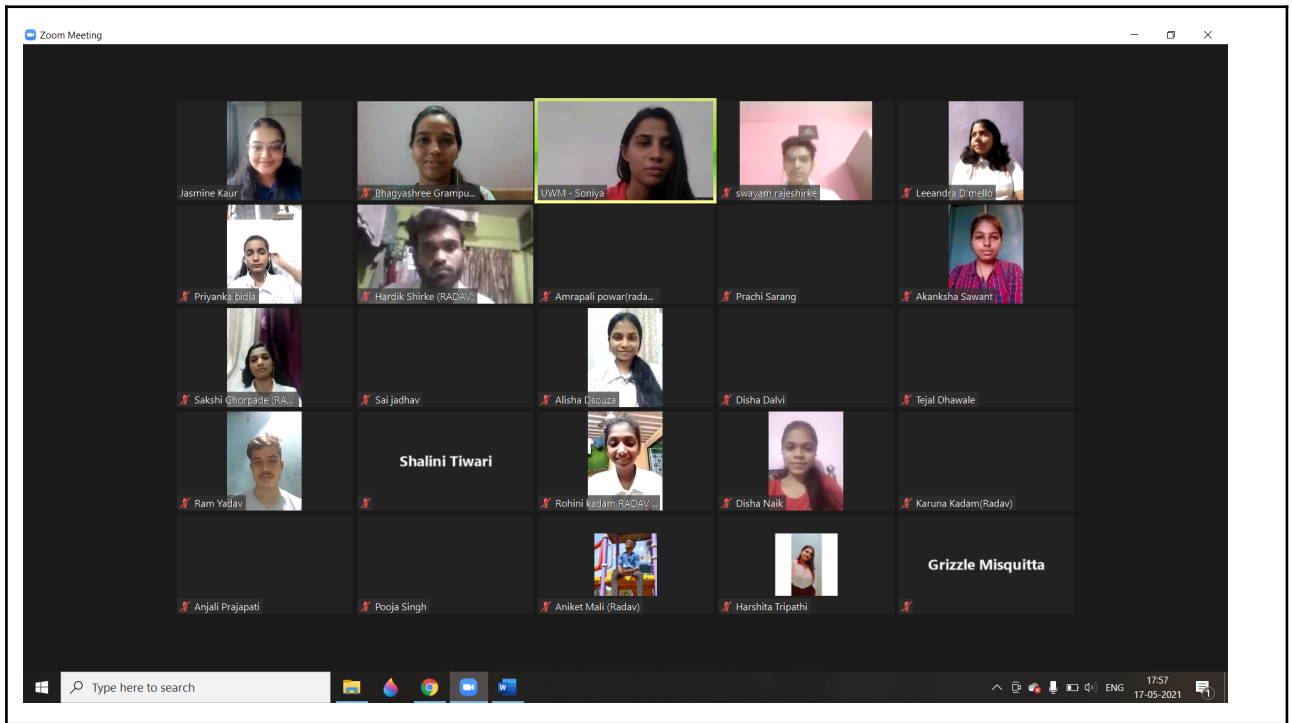
