STUDENT WELFARE SCHEME: 2020– 21

REPORT

The Goal:

With an objective of community outreach and extension, college has instituted, the ‘LATE SHREE RAJPAL KAPOOR FOUNDATION’, a cooperative trust in remembrance of first Hon. Secretary of Uttari Bharat Sabha. Under its ‘STUDENT WELFARE SCHEME’, which is a flagship programme of the foundation, the college awards scholarships to deserving and needy students. The college is getting a huge response from college staff and external philanthropists to finance the student welfare scheme.

Like every year, in the meeting chaired by Principal, Dr. Ajay Bhamare everyone unanimously decided to give away the entire collected fund amount as Student Scholarship award to needy and deserving students. This year total INR **1,90,000** has been collected. The collected amount has been distributed to around **76 students**.

The Context:

The students are generally informed about the scheme through the prospectus, a general circular and the notice which is displayed at all the prominent places in the college premises. The college prospectus contains the application for the same. This year due to pandemic situation students were informed about this scheme through WhatsApp groups of the college. Criteria for selection of candidate for awarding scholarship is not only need based but also merit based. Deserving candidates from economically weak background receive this scholarship. Priority is given to students who are not getting the benefit of any other scholarship/ freeship /financial aid. The intention is to help genuinely needy students in best way possible.

In year 2020-21, we could not receive any application from first year B.Com students and face to face interview could not be conducted therefore, students from S.Y.B Com and T.Y.B Com were given the priority for receiving this scholarship based on the interviews conducted during year 2019-20.

The Practice:

After applications are received, they are scrutinized and students are called for personal interview by the selection committee.

Problems encountered and resources required:

The biggest difficulty is the outreach. Even after due publicity and information provided to students, the committee feels that deserving and needy students are hesitant to approach the committee for various reasons, the main reason being peer fear. Announcements are done multiple times in the classroom but students do not feel comfortable to reveal their financial position in front of everyone. Therefore, they approach the committee later. This sometimes causes delay in the process of collection of documents. In this situation, teachers encourage students to fill up the scholarship form.

Due to pandemic, there was delay in the process of admissions. All the stakeholders of the college were trying to establish the order as earlier for first few months. Therefore, new students could not get maximum benefit of the scheme.

Rupee Revolution scheme, an activity of collecting one rupee from each student and donating the received funding to the Late Shree Rajpal Kapoor Foundation scheme could not be conducted.

There was no demand for hard copy of books in college library as students were attending college online. Therefore, funding book bank scheme and maintaining the activity of this scheme was not possible.

Getting a regular stream of philanthropists and fund contributors is another area of difficulty faced by committee.

Evidence of success:

It is observed by the committee that the beneficiaries of the scheme tend to be more regular and punctual not only in studies but also in co- curricular activities. It is also noticed that a positive and encouraging behavioral change takes place amongst student and they become more responsible citizens.

It is observed that students tend to attend lectures more passionately and they take efforts for getting the scholarship every year.

The committee wishes to increase the number of beneficiaries in the future and thereby help to change the social fabric of the local community.

Multi -Layered Plastic Waste Collection
2020-21

The Goal:

Plastic Pollution is a well-known environmental problem. Single use plastic is banned everywhere in India. But some problems regarding the use of plastic still persist. For example, use of Multilayered Plastic in commercial or industrial sector. MLP waste is widely used in the market as it is lightweight, available in different sizes and most importantly useful in protecting food.

Multi layered plastic has several thin sheets of material consisting of aluminum, plastic, paper etc. laminated together. Multilayered plastic is largely used for packaging. The most common way to dispose of this type of plastic is land filling or incineration. Recycling this waste is comparatively a good option. Recycling MLP waste is difficult as it is made up of various different materials having different boiling points. The goal of this initiative was to encourage recycling of MLP waste.

The Context:

Safai Bank of India is a project by Mumbai Sustainability Centre which is a non-profit company. It provides a platform for those organizations who are willing to contribute to MLP waste collection and recycling. It collects MLP waste from various organizations and disposes it off as per the Waste Management Rules 2016. Waste is recycled and used for construction of roads.

The college took part in this initiative of collecting waste in December 2020 after an awareness program conducted in the college on 12 November 2020 by Safai Bank of India.

The Practice:

The NSS volunteers prepared posters and circulated it along with the notice and information in the college through social media platforms. Volunteers also created a Google spreadsheet for the students for entering their name and number of MLP wrappers collected by them. Because of lockdown and COVID regulations, these wrappers could not be collected in the college.

Students and volunteers stored them at their homes. As soon as the lockdown rules were relaxed, NSS volunteers collected all the wrappers from the students in March 2021. The college could collect 2788 MLP wrappers with the help of teachers, students and NSS volunteers. 118 students participated in this initiative.

In future, the college would like to take this initiative a step ahead by generating awareness in locality. People living in nearby areas will be encouraged to participate in this activity. Street plays and awareness sessions including social media awareness can be organized for this purpose.

Problems Encountered and Resources required:

The practical challenges in collection and segregation of MLPs is that it requires storage space due to its voluminous nature and it is labour intensive. This makes recycling of MLP economically unviable and is mostly destined to end up in landfill. However, few technological interventions have made it possible to manage this waste.

Because of lockdown initially it was difficult to collect the MLP waste. But once college reopened, students started giving good response and tried their best in collecting this waste.

Evidence of success:

The college was successful in collecting 2788 packets of waste till March 2021.
