CONFERRMENT OF AUTONOMOUS STATUS

The most important milestone recorded by the college during this period, has been the conferment of the 'Autonomous' status by the University Grants Commission and the University of Mumbai on the college with effect from the academic year 2021-2022, thereby providing the opportunity to the institution to introduce new programmes and courses as well as revising the existing syllabus to make them more employability oriented.


EXTENSION IN VALIDITY OF NAAC GRADE

The statutory meetings of the Governing Body, CDC, Academic Council, Finance Committee and the Boards of Studies were conducted during the period to discuss and formally approve the various proposals relating to college development, budget allocation, syllabus revision, etc. The first year syllabi of all UG programmes was thoroughly discussed at the respective BOS meetings and formally approved by the Academic Council and Governing Body after due deliberations. The approved syllabi came into force from the commencement of the academic year 2021-2022. The financial proposals for the year were discussed at the Finance Committee meeting and duly approved by the Governing Body.

NEW PROGRAMMES & COURSES INTRODUCED FROM ACADEMIC YEAR 2021-2022

From the Academic Year 2021-2022, the college has introduced the following three new employability-oriented undergraduate programmes with a built-in internship opportunity.

1. B.Sc. (Hons) in Fashion Design & Technology,
2. B.B.A (Hons) - Bachelor of Business Administration
3. B.B.A. (Hons) - Bachelor of Business Administration in Marketing Management.

The results of our students for the academic year 2020-2021 under various programmes are listed below. It is gratifying to note that the results registered by the college are well above the university average, in all the programmes.






NOTABLE ACHIEVEMENT BY OUR STUDENT

CAREER GUIDANCE AND PLACEMENT ACTIVITIES DURING THE YEAR



NSS INITIATIVES DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

The National Service Scheme (NSS) unit of the college has undertaken various community assistance initiatives during this year to bring succour to the people affected by the Covid-19 pandemic.


CULTURAL ACTIVITIES ORGANIZED DURING THE YEAR


A total of 2022 students of the college from all programmes registered for the various events. The female participants were quite high at 1246 compared to 776 male students.




