## Bachelor of commences (Finances Market) Mumbai University Degree Course,

## (1) ELIGIBILITY:

A candidate to be eligible for admission to the Bachelor of Commerce (Financial Markets) Degree Course shall have passed XII Std. Examination of the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary & Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent one & the same sitting.

Every candidate admitted to the Degree Course in the Constituent/affiliated college/recognized institution, conducting the course, shall have to register himself/herself with the University.

## (2) DURATION OF THE COURSE AND RELATED INFORMATION.

- (a) The course shall be a full time course. The duration of the course shall be six semesters spread over in three years.
- (b) Intake Capacity 60 students:
- (c) The course shall consist of 38 modules of 100 marks each & 2 projects of 100 marks each. Total 400 marks.
- (d) Total number of lectures per paper per semester shall be maximum 60 of 50 minutes duration each. Number of lectures per paper per week shall be 4 in case of Theory papers.
- (e) For subjects having practical component like 1.3, 1.4, 2.3, 3.5 & 6.3, total no. of Theory lectures per paper per week shall be 3 & I lecture of practical (consisting the duration equal to 3 lectures of 50 minutes) per week per batch. (Batch is of 20 Students)
- (f) On an average 15 working weeks area available in every semester.
